Due to the uncertainty of the moment, we will need to have multiple options/ plans to complete the semester. In order to make these plans, I need information from you and good communication with you.

PLease answer the questionaire the college is sending, but also reply to this email and answer my specific questions: (you can reply and insert your answers)

- 1. Where are you now and where will you be starting next week? (what time zone?) (street address)
- 2. What is your phone number? (do you see texts faster than email?)
- 3. What type of computer do you have? Can it handle Adobe Suite? Dragonframe? (if free)
- 4. What type of internet connection do you have? can it handle live streaming, google meets, etc?
- 5. Do you have some type of camera? (from a smart phone, to webcam, to DSLR) what type
- 6. Do you have a tripod? or any type of holder for your camera?
- 7. Do you have a drawing tablet, ipad?
- 8. How large a space will you have to work while you are home? (compare to your space in 101)

Before break I handed out the final assignment description. The prompt involved starting with an autobiographical fact. Although this is still the main prompt, I wonder if you might want the option to respond creatively to the current situation with the coronovirus?
