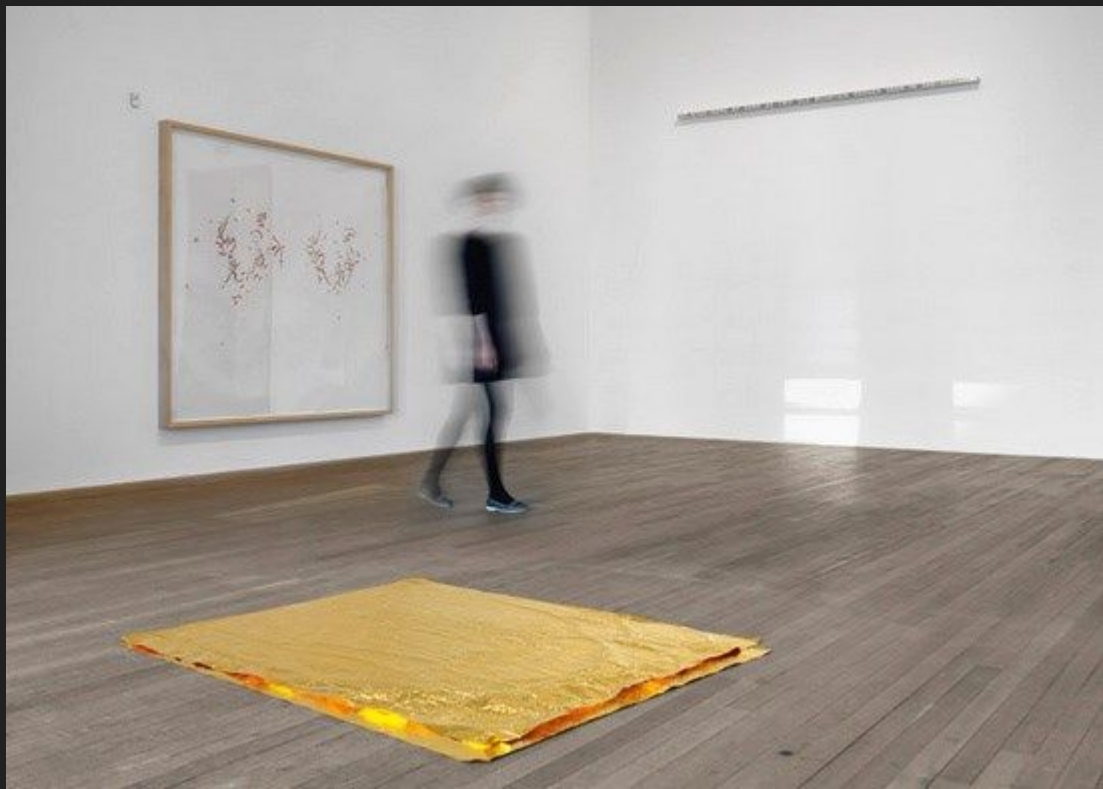

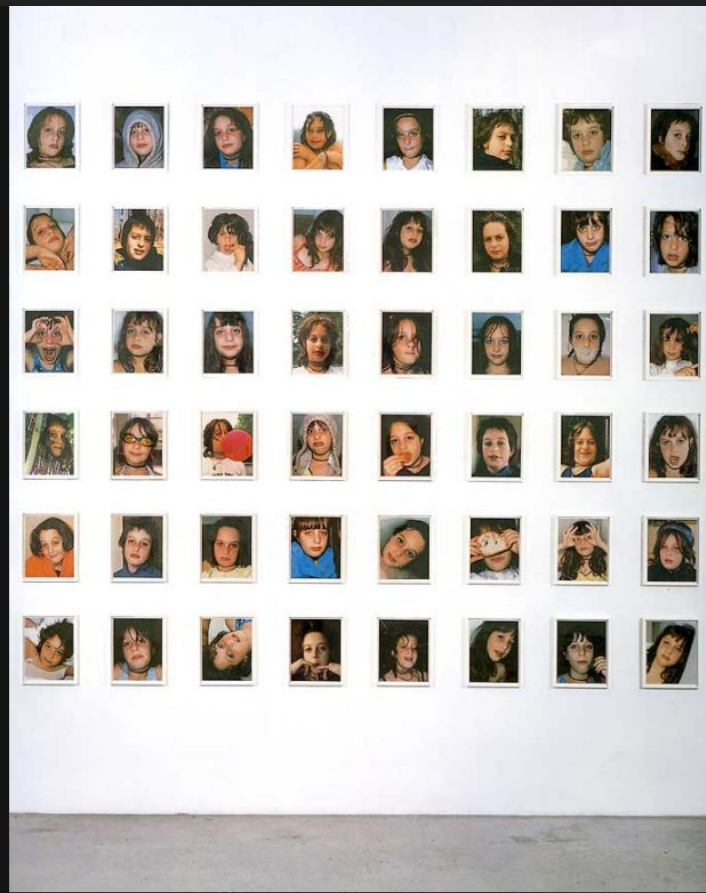

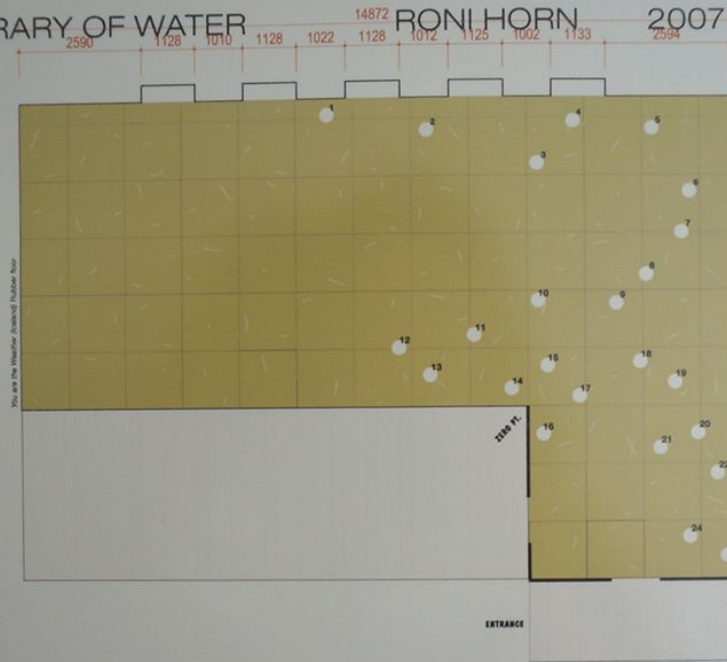

## WATER, SELECTED-

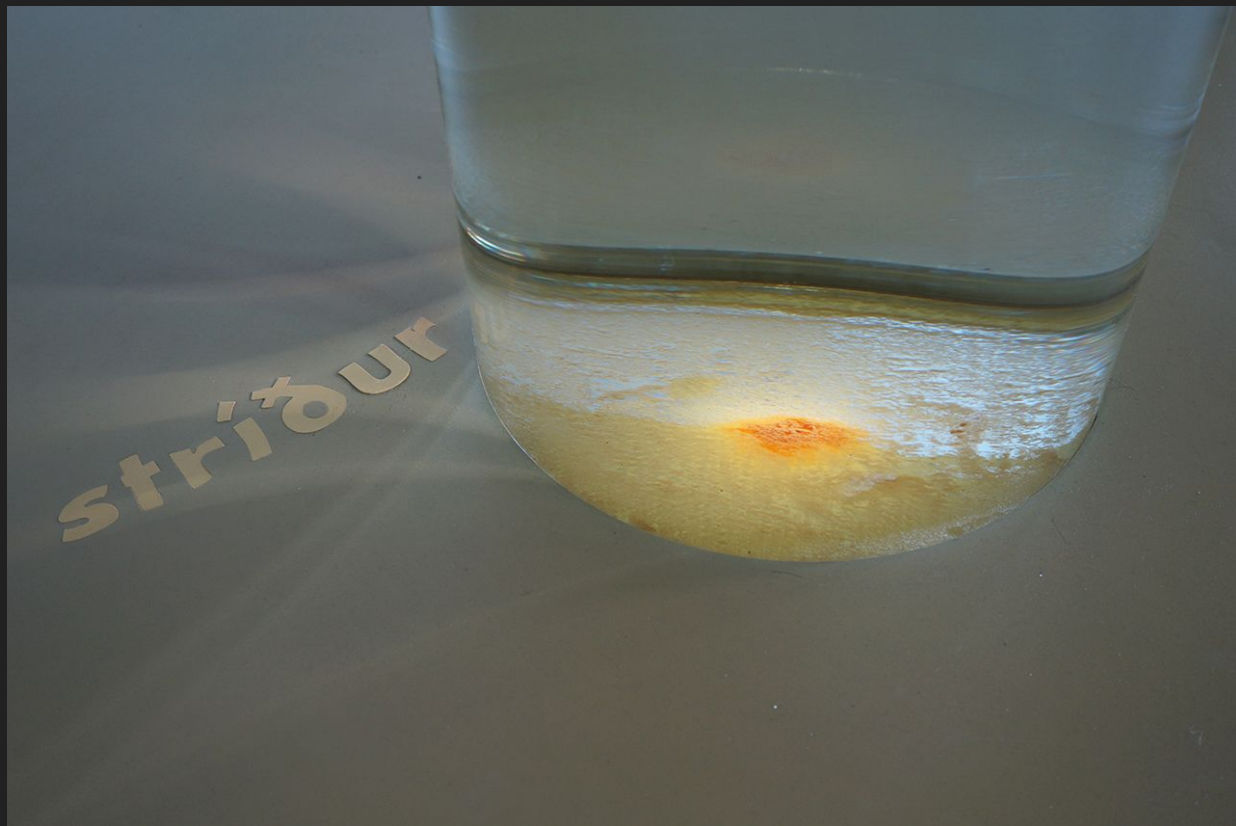
an archive of water collected as ice from twenty-four unique glacial sources throughout Iceland. The water is stored in floor-to-ceiling glass columns permanently installed on site. Each column is dedicated to a single glacial source. The columns are 12 in. / 30 cm. in diameter by 118 in. / 3 meters high.
